#### The Eiffel and the Montmartre

Today after Breakfast, Let's begin where Paris did, on the Ile de la Cité. You shall be leading your tour of the city's early history, including a pair of the world's most significant Medieval Gothic churches: the resilient and legendary Notre-Dame Cathedral and a visit to the exquisite Sainte-Chapelle. We shall then head to Luxembourg Gardens and drive through Montparnasse. You take a stroll through the bohemian Latin Quarter, with free time for lunch on your own. We shall then visit the Eiffel Tower and climb up to the second level, from where you can enjoy the magnificent view of the whole city. Post the tour of Eiffel take a long walk from Alexander Bridge, covering Arc de Triomphe and Champs Eleyesse. Later, then hike up Montmartre to tour the colourful neighbourhood that was the haunt of artistic geniuses a century ago — including Van Gogh, Picasso, and Renoir — and generations of hopeful artists since. We shall drive to the Montmartre Quarter where we shall end our walk with spectacular views of Paris from the Sacré-Cœur Basilica. We'll shall then enjoy dinner together.





### Chateaux de Versailles, Marais District & the Louvre

Today after Breakfast at Hotel, explore the elaborate palace that Louis XIV, XV, and XVI called home. You shall make the 30-minute trip to Versailles, where you can witness the dazzling Hall of Mirrors and other sumptuous rooms of the palace. You'll then have free time to wander through the expansive gardens.

We shall then Zip Back to Paris diverse, history-layered Marais district. As we walk, we'll learn about enlightened 17th-century urban planning at the beautiful Place des Vosges, the cultural roots of the Jewish Quarter, and how the French Revolution grew from this neighbourhood. We shall then visit the Tuileries Garden, and reach The Louvre. This evening, Europe's greatest museum — the Louvre — is open late, and we'll take full advantage of that. You'll come face to face with the works of Raphael, Delacroix, and Leonardo, and timeless treasures including Mona Lisa, Winged Victory, Venus de Milo, and hundreds more. Tonight, we'll enjoy a farewell feast at Paris at an Indian Restaurant. Salut!

### **Scenic Drive to Switzerland**

The rest of the day is all yours to explore the beautiful city of Lucerne, find a cosy mountain hut offering beautiful views, or shop for some amazing Swiss chocolates.

# **Hiking in the Berner Oberland**

Don't sleep in this morning — the day is all yours to experience some of Switzerland's best hiking. Join your guide for an optional ride to the lcy air streams across your face, snow crunches under your feet, and the view nearly takes your breath away: on one side the view of the Mitte land up to the Vosges, on the other the Aletsch glacier, bordered by four thousand metre peaks. Standing on the Jungfrau 3,454 metres above sea level, you can feel it with your first step: this is a different world. It's one you have to experience. Later, we shall visit Interlaken for an orientation Tour followed by some shopping time in Switzerland

# Matterhorn and the Heart of the Alps

This morning we'll leave drive to the heart of Switzerland's Berner Oberland. Along the way we'll visit the quaint mountain village of Zermatt, framed by Switzerland's iconic Matterhorn. We'll have free time to explore the village and enjoy the views of one of the most recognizable mountains on the planet before we zip back to our hotel for dinner this evening.

Your evening is free to explore Florence before we head for Dinner.
