02 Progressive, Artistic Amsterdam

Explore the exquisite Dutch countryside away from the busy city of Amsterdam on this Netherlands Vacation! Wake up and feast on a scrumptious breakfast. On the second day of your Netherlands tour, venture out of the city to take a half-day tour to the famous little village of Zaanse Schans with your family. Explore this unique historical town, with its majestic windmills and wooden houses and traditional crafts. Visit a clog maker and observe how the famous Dutch wooden shoe is made and proceed to visit a cheese farm afterward. Lastly, you can visit the 17th-century working windmill to experience the history of the Dutch countryside.

After your amazing half day tour, get back to Amsterdam, this afternoon gets chummy with this great city's gabled houses, bridges, and canals while learning why the Golden Age glimmered so brightly here. Take an historic walk through the heart of the city, stopping to visit the Anne Frank House for a thought-provoking look at the hideaway of Anne and her family during the Nazi occupation of the Netherlands. We shall then hop on to the famous Canal Cruise for an orientation tour of the canal laced city before we continue on to a local "coffeeshop" to learn about this nation's creative, pragmatic approach to drug policy. Your evening is free for more adventures in Amsterdam or back in Haarlem.

03 Tulip Treats and Rhine Views

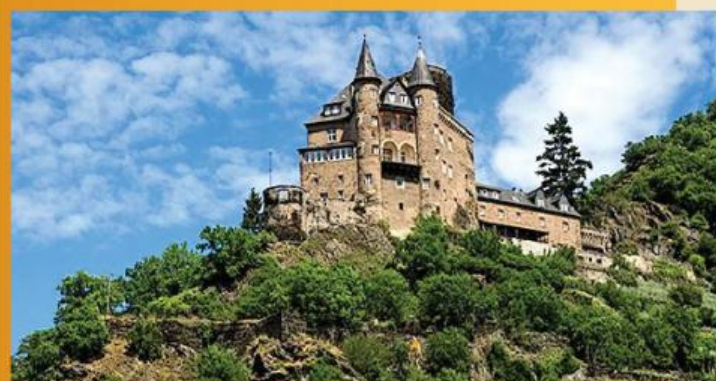


04 Rhine Castles and a River Cruise

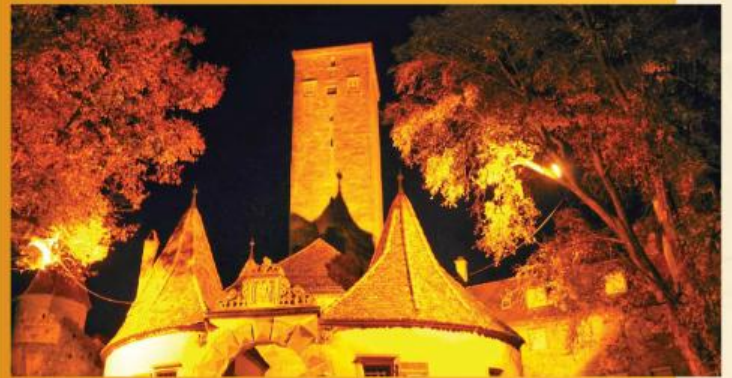


05 Medieval Rothenberg

This evening we'll tag along on the legendary Night Watchman's tour. Sleep in Rothenberg (1 night).

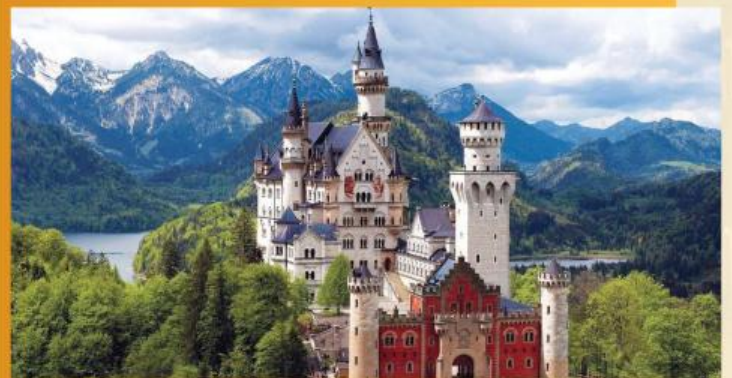


06 Neuschwanstein and the Swarovski

We'll begin our day, drive across the Bavarian countryside to visit Germany's, "Mad" King Ludwig's deservedly famous Neuschwanstein Castle. This afternoon you'll be free to visit another nearby castle, take a stroll in the woods, and have time for lunch in the famous town of Fussen. Winding our way toward Austria - characterized by mountain villages, baroque architecture, Imperial history and rugged Alpine terrain, we'll arrive at the Swarovski Crystal Garden at Wattens, and engage yourselves into shopping for Crystals best known in the World.

07 To the Heart of the Swiss Alps

Today after Breakfast we shall climb high into the heart of the Swiss Alps. Our destination is the Berner Oberland's, flanked by towering, waterfall-laced cliffs and crowned by a trio of Switzerland's most formidable peaks: the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau. On our way we shall be driving pass, the famous Black Forest Region of Germany and take a trip to Cuckoo Clock factory. Then we proceed to Schaffhausen to view the Rhine River falls – biggest fall in the continent of Europe Tonight, we'll share a hearty dinner together at our creaky chalet. Where we'll stay for 4 Nights.

08 Peaks of Engelberg And Mount Titlis

After Breakfast, nestled between two mountain peaks, Engelberg is the perfect place for an Alpine adventure. We'll begin our day riding Engelberg's unique rotating gondola all the way up to the snowy 10,000-foot summit of Mount Titlis for breath-taking panoramic views. This afternoon we'll gather to tour the town's Benedictine monastery, with its own cheese-making operation. The rest of the day is all yours to explore the beautiful city of Lucerne, find a cosy mountain hut offering beautiful views, or shop for some amazing Swiss chocolates.

09 Hiking in the Berner Oberland

Don't sleep in this morning — the day is all yours to experience some of Switzerland's best hiking. Join your guide for an optional ride to the icy air streams across your face, snow crunches under your feet, and the view nearly takes your breath away: on one side the view of the Mittel Land up to the Vosges, on the other the Aletsch glacier, bordered by four thousand metre peaks in the Cog wheel train (the only rail to reach the height of 11000 feet). Standing on the Jungfrau 3,454 metres above sea level, you can feel it with your first step: this is a different world. It's one you have to experience.

Later, we shall visit Interlaken for an orientation Tour followed by some shopping time in Switzerland
